Livonian Order Castle Ruins

Dietrich von Groningen, master of the Order, began the first Castellum type castle construction in the 13th century. At the beginning, the castle had a courtyard, corner towers and wooden buildings in the courtyard. It served as a protective border zone where the territory of the Courland bishop and the Livonian Order met. In the 15th century,

Aizpute Local History Museum

The new manor complex was built at the turn of the 18th to 19th century, on the left bank of the River Tebra. The owners of the castle the Firks family - moved into the new manor house, and the manor servants were housed in the old castle. A windmill and distillery were built by the pond, as well as farm outbuildings near the manor house. After the agrarian reform, a gymnasium (school) was located in the manor house. The Aizpute Local History museum currently has quarters

Church hill and Aizpute St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church Until the 13th century, the church hill was a hillfort for the Curonians, the ancient tribe in Latvia, and the Beida castle of the ancient



Curonians was located on it. When German crusaders invaded the hillfort, St. John's church was built in the place of the castle in the 13th century, and it is currently one of the oldest buildings in Courland (Latvian: Kurzeme). Approximately 40 years after the building of the church – in 1295,

when Bishop Burkhard governed – Aizpute became the capital of the Courland Bishopric and its monastery hosted the Domkapitel. The church holds an organ made by the well-known German producer Sauer in 1904. The tombstone of the Bishop of Courland, H. Basedow, in the 16th century can be seen on the right side near the altar. 




Aizpute is one of the oldest towns in Latvia. It is situated on the right bank of the river Tebra. The first records of the town buildings can be found from the 14th century. The oldest part of the town was located in the territory surrounded by Atmodas, Jāņa, and Katolu streets, but later it

was expanded towards Jelgavas, Kalvenes, and Kuldīgas streets.

Synagogues (Aizpute House of Culture)

In 1751, one of the first Jewish communities in Courland (Latvian:



population was Jewish. Aizpute Synagogue is the oldest of the currently existing synagogues there and was built in 1751. The Small Synagogue was built next to it in 1875. In 1941, all Jews dwelling in Aizpute were gathered together in the synagogue and brought to Kalvene in trucks where they

11 Baptist Church

Church was built in accordance with the project of Aleksander Šmēlings and consecrated at Christmas of 1939. At the beginning, the pastor's






Kazdanga Castle and Manor Kazdanga castle and manor was owned by the powerful Courland (Latvian: Kurzeme) barons von Manteuffels. Kazdanga castle was built by the famous Western European architect J. G. Berlitz in the early 19th century in the classicist style. Currently, the castle houses a

museum where visitors can explore the history of Kazdanga village and see an exposition of "Bojas" Forestry Museum. Jaunatnes gatve 1, Kazdanga, (+371) 29103813, (+371) 28616717,



Cavalier House and Granary Kazdanga castle was built simultaneously with two granaries on its sides where one was later turned into a cavaliers' house. This building preserves the peculiar baroque circular stairs that lead up to the

attic. The interior is decorated by a genre mural "Kazdanga 1888. To the market." painted by two Latvian artists L. Gintere and F. Kirke in 1976 in the tempera technique. The stone bridge, which was built, in 1840 leads to Kazdanga castle at the end of an alley of linden trees and crosses a ravine. The bridge is popularly called the bridge of sighs (Latvian: Vaidu tilts). Why sighs? It is

because a lot of tears, sweat and blood were shed when the bridge was built. The top of the bridge has small granite columns with iron chains and ornaments. Currently visible chains are said to have been used on ships. A fragment of a chain from the barons' period is on display in the museum.

4 Former manor pub building

He pub building was erected in 1868. The pub owner and his family lived in the northern end of the building. The middle section was used as a pub but the southern end was used for accommodating travellers and their horses overnight. During the period of Baron Karl Wilhelm,




the pub was converted into a tea room. This building is a national monument of culture, and its main attractions and values are the facade, the old semi-circular arched windows and doors, as well as two iron wind indicators made in 1667. Liepu gatve 8, Kazdanga

(5) Former manor horse stable (Kazdanga House of Culture) Initially, the building was made as a house for servants in 1686. In 1914,

it was converted into a horse stable, and then (1957-1959) the stable was rebuilt to use it as a house of culture. The interior decoration was



created by the Latvian artist Albins Dzenis and wood sculptor Ernests Treimanis by applying the national style. Currently, the building hosts a cultural centre and a library. Pils gatve 4, Kazdanga, (+371) 26681805, (+371) 63497017






